WORLD MEMORIAL 9/11 TRIBUTE

September 11, 2008

WHEREAS; the WORLD MEMORIAL, a non-profit charity, educates citizens on the events that took place on September 11, 2001 while teaching truth and tolerance; and

WHEREAS; the mission of the WORLD MEMORIAL is to deliver the message, "Keeping the memories alive;" and

WHEREAS; the WORLD MEMORIAL honors the Public Safety personnel that work for the City of San Diego who place their lives on the line every day to protect our City; and

WHEREAS; the WORLD MEMORIAL honors the Public Safety personnel that made the "Supreme Sacrifice" in the line of duty as well as the civilians that were lost. Well over 25,000 civilians were saved; 401 public safety personnel and one K-9 gave their lives to save people they did not know; and

WHEREAS; on September 11, 2008, the WORLD MEMORIAL will display a 9/11 Memorial in The City of San Diego for the seventh anniversary of 9/11; and

WHEREAS; the WORLD MEMORIAL will display a piece of the World Trade Center which WORLD MEMORIAL obtained through coordinated efforts of the FDNY Chief Cassano and former San Diego Fire Chief Bowman; and

WHEREAS; the members of WORLD MEMORIAL will work with the City of San Diego to construct a fitting and respectful memorial in which the WTC steel will eventually become part of a 9/11 Memorial for the citizens of San Diego, visitors of San Diego and family members from the 9/11/01 community; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council hereby proclaims **September 11**, **2008** as "WORLD MEMORIAL 9/11 Tribute Day" in the City of San Diego.
